### New Family Discount

- New family discount: **\$1,000** per student for the 2017-2018 school year and **\$500** per student for the 2018-2019 school year
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### Application Fee (new families)

- Application/Testing Fee: \$100 per student

### Enrollment Contract Fees include the following:

- **Enrollment Fee:** \$100.00 per student

*The enrollment fee of \$100 is non-refundable and must be paid at the time of enrollment. This fee secures your child's spot in the class and is applied directly to registration fee balance. The total enrollment fee is **non-refundable** except in cases where financial aid is applied for and the request is not granted.*

**\*\*Enrollment fees are due at the time the enrollment contract is signed and delivered to Kingswood Academy.**

### Registration Fees (Book Fees) include the following:

- **Instructional Fees:** \$150.00 per student  
These include textbook rental and workbooks, classroom materials, field trips, art materials, audio-visual materials, annual calendar, and one family yearbook.
- **Technology fee:** \$100.00 per student

## **Graduation Fees**

- Graduation Fee: \$50 per 8th Grade Student

*After School Activities and Extended Care Programs will have their own additional fee.*

## **Fundraising Obligations:**

- **Benefit Dinner: \$1200 obligation goes directly toward supporting financial aid**  
Kingswood is a private, independent school and receives no Illinois state or diocesan aid. Therefore, there is an additional fundraising obligation of \$1,200. Fulfillment of the Benefit requirement can be met in a number of ways. Every year Kingswood hosts an Annual Benefit Dinner, which is the largest Fundraising event of the school year. Each family is required, by contract, to sell or purchase 4 tickets at \$125 per ticket for a total of \$500. The remaining \$700 responsibility can be met by purchasing Benefit raffle ticket sales and/or securing ads for the Benefit Ad booklet. Lastly, 40% of contributions above the fundraising - requirement will be applied to your tuition. *(Consult your financial advisor for tax deductible donation information.)*
- **Other Fundraisers that go directly towards the operation of the school include:**
  - **Annual Appeal, Walk-A-Thon, and Kingswood Academy's Golf Outing**

## **Tuition Discounts:**

Discount for siblings in grades K through 8<sup>th</sup> are available and listed on page 1.

There is a \$1,000 surcharge for Pre-K students (Pre-K tuition = \$6,900) due to the fact that we typically need an assistant teacher in Pre-K to satisfy state requirements. Pre-K students are not part of the sibling discounts or the new family discount.

Note: No returning family for the 2017-18 year will have a total tuition bill greater than a comparable tuition bill calculated under the tuition structure of the 2016-17 year.

## **Financial Aid:**

Financial Aid is available to all families who qualify and only to their children enrolled in a 5 full day program.
