New Family Discount

New family discount: **\$1,000 per family** for the 2020-2021 school year in Kindergarten through 8th grade.

Application Fee (new families)

Application/Testing Fee: \$100 per student

Enrollment Contract Fees include the following:

Enrollment Fee: \$100.00 per student

*The enrollment fee of \$100 is non-refundable and must be paid at the time of enrollment. This fee secures your child's spot in the class and is applied directly towards book fee balance. The total enrollment fee is **non-refundable** except in cases where financial aid is applied for and the request is not granted.*

****Enrollment fees are due at the time the enrollment contract is signed and delivered to Kingswood Academy in order to hold your child's spot.**

Book and Technology Fees include the following:

Book and technology fees: \$300.00 per student

These include textbook rental and workbooks, classroom materials, field trips, art materials, audio-visual materials, annual calendar, and one family yearbook.

Graduation Fee: \$50 per 8th Grade Student

After School Activities and Extended Care Program Fees

After School Activities and Extended Care Programs will have their own additional fee.

Fundraising:

Fundraising Commitment: \$300 per family which may be applied towards 2 tickets to the Annual Benefit Dinner

Annual Benefit Dinner:

Kingswood is an independent school and receives no funding from the state of Illinois, Diocese of Joliet, or any other outside institution. The cost of a Kingswood education exceeds the price of tuition and fundraising is a very important part of the annual budget. Every year Kingswood hosts an Annual Benefit Dinner, which is the largest fundraising event of the school year. Kingswood parents are strongly encouraged to attend the Benefit Dinner, invite family and friends, and to volunteer their time and talent to help make the Dinner a great success.

Tuition Discounts:

Discount for siblings in grades K through 8th are available and listed on page 1.

There is a \$900 surcharge for Pre-K students (Pre-K tuition = \$6,800) in order to satisfy the state requirement to include an assistant teacher in the Pre-K classroom. **Pre-K students are not part of the sibling discounts or the new family discount.**

Financial Aid:

Financial Aid is available to all families who qualify and only to their children enrolled in a 5 full day program.
